Data Protection Privacy Notice

This notice explains what personal data (information) we will hold about you, how we collect it, and how we will use and may share information about you during the application process. We are required to notify you of this information, under data protection legislation. Please ensure that you read this notice (sometimes referred to as a 'privacy notice') and any other similar notice we may provide to you from time to time when we collect or process personal information about you.

WHO COLLECTS THE INFORMATION

Cheshire Rugby Union ('Company') is a 'data controller' and gathers and uses certain information about you.

DATA PROTECTION PRINCIPLES

We will comply with the data protection principles when gathering and using personal information, as set out in our DATA PROTECTION POLICY

ABOUT THE INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND HOLD

The table set out in below summarises the information we collect and hold, how and why we do so, how we use it and with whom it may be shared.

We seek to ensure that our information collection and processing is always proportionate. We will notify you of any changes to information we collect or to the purposes for which we collect and process it.

WHERE INFORMATION MAY BE HELD

Information may be held at our offices and those of our group companies, and third party agencies, service providers, representatives and agents as described above.

HOW LONG WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION

We keep the personal information that we obtain about you <u>during your membership and for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which it is processed.</u> How long we keep your information will depend on the nature of the information concerned and the purposes for which it is processed.

We will keep information for no longer than is reasonable, taking into account the limitation periods for potential claims such as race or sex discrimination (as extended to take account of early conciliation), after which they will be destroyed. If there is a clear business reason for keeping records for longer, we may do so but will first consider whether the records can be pseudonymised, and the longer period for which they will be kept.

Further details on our approach to information retention and destruction are available in our Data Protection policy that gives these details.

YOUR RIGHTS TO CORRECT AND ACCESS YOUR INFORMATION AND TO ASK FOR IT TO BE ERASED

Our Data Protection Officer will provide you with further information about the right to be forgotten, if you ask for it.

KEEPING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION SECURE

We have appropriate security measures in place to prevent personal information from being accidentally lost or used or accessed in an unauthorised way. We limit access to your personal information to those who have a genuine business need to know it. Those processing your information will do so only in an authorised manner and are subject to a duty of confidentiality.

We also have procedures in place to deal with any suspected data security breach. We will notify you and any applicable regulator of a suspected data security breach where we are legally required to do so.
